## OBJECTIVES

Express reasoned points of view which are contrasted with their own experiences.

- Describe the dimensions of the personal self in the context of interpersonal relationships.
- To analyze the impact of disruptive technologies on the ways of working and relating to other people, as well as their legal and ethical implications.
- To analyze the content of the values that people and institutions disseminate and manifest.
- Justify the ethical values that should govern professional practice, as well as the relationships between institutions and public and private organizations.
